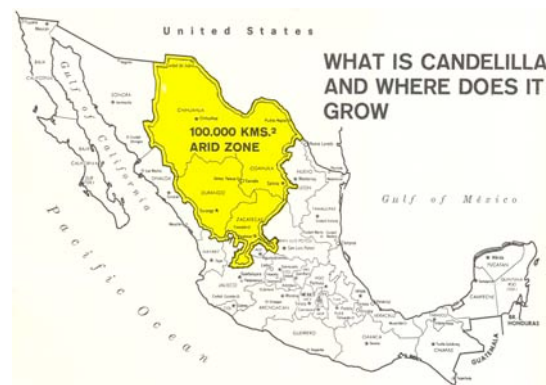
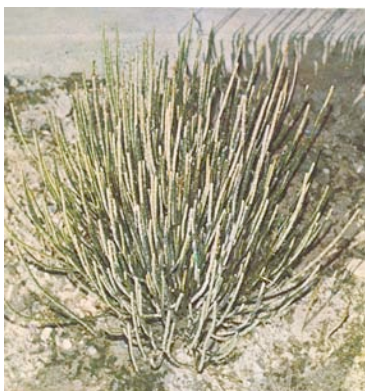


Candelilla Wax

Candelilla, a vegetable wax, is found in the form of scales entirely covering a reed-like plant which grows wild in northwestern Mexico. It is hard, brittle, slightly tacky and a lustrous wax with a distinctive odor.

The wax is used for polishes, cosmetics, lubricants, adhesives, chewing gum, and paper coatings.
