The Carnauba Palm grows in the northern and northeastern parts of Brazil along the river banks and can reach heights of 40' to 50' tall. Only in Northern Brazil does the Carnauba Palm produce wax.

Carnauba wax is a hard, brittle, non-tacky and lustrous wax. It is a preferred ingredient in polishes, cosmetics, castings, lubricants, glazing, inks, candles, and protective coatings.
